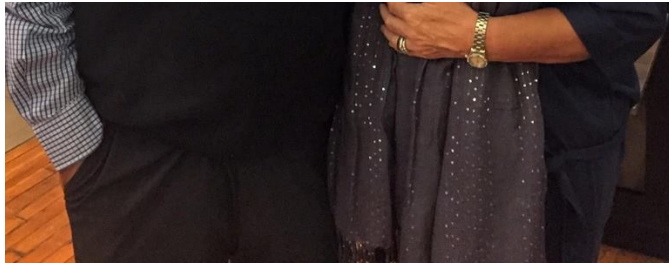

Lexi Swanepoel won the Singles Medal competition with a **75** nett.



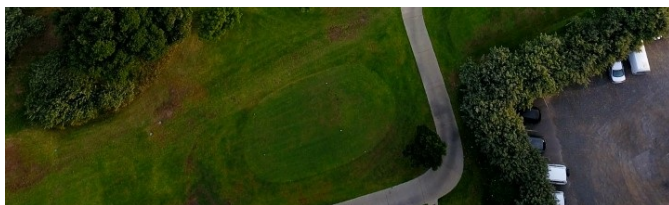

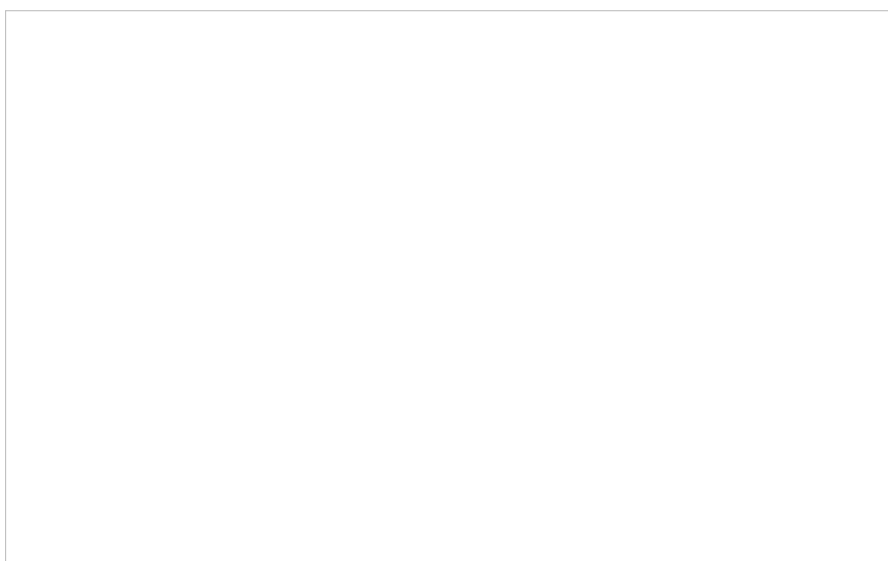
