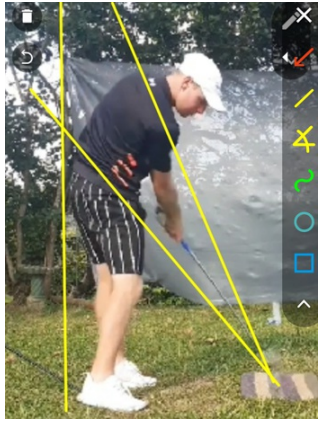
## Remote Coaching
