World Handicap System update #9

Low Handicap Index

We continue with updates on the changes for the new World Handicap System. This week we cover Low Handicap Index. The new World Handicap will keep track of the lowest your handicap has been over the last 12 months and will use this as a way to limit your upward movement in the handicap range. Essentially this is a way that the new system is trying to

help eliminate the potential of sandbagging. The Low Handicap Index will also be used in certain events at CCL such as Jambalea and Men's Quota to help limit handicap management around those events.

We will continue with the format of seven 9-hole matches and flights of 8 teams.

A member must be present and have the sign up form completed to sign-up. If a member can't be there then they can have somebody stand in for them to bring the sign-up sheet.

The sign-ups will be taken on a first come first serve basis.

will be taken when they get to the front of the line.

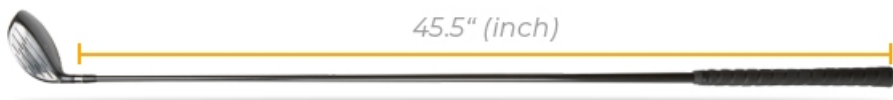
They will need to get back in line to turn the second sheet in.
