PGA Diploma graduate Muhammad Warraich recently placed 2nd in a professional event in Pakistan, earning himself the equivalent of approximately R30,000.



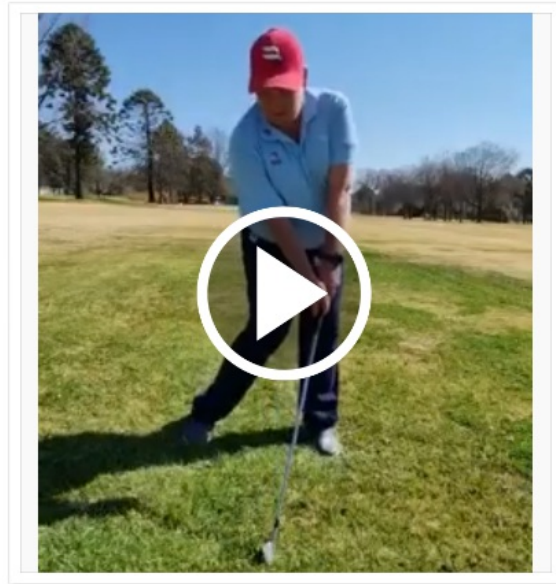
